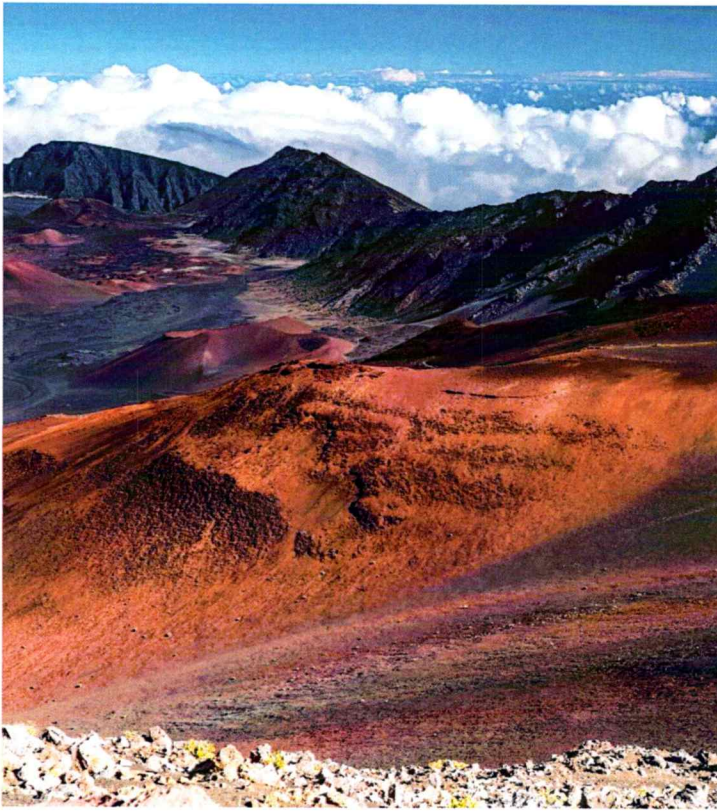

Days 10 – 12 Outrigger Kauai Beach Resort & Spa, Kauai, HI

On some dates alternate hotels may be used.

Day 1: Thursday, May 6, 2027 Honolulu, O'ahu Aloha! Your adventure begins on the sun-drenched beaches of Waikiki. Relax and "hang loose" before meeting your group tomorrow, there are no inclusions today.

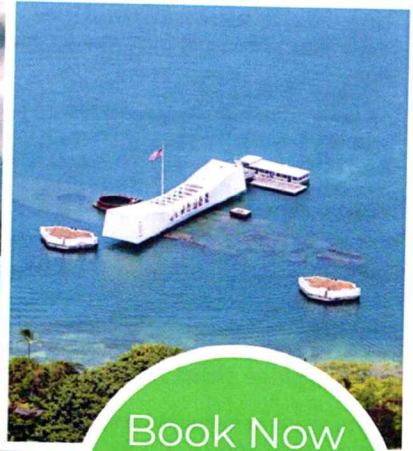
Day 2: Friday, May 7, 2027 Honolulu This morning, take a city tour of Honolulu, highlighting the historic Iolani Palace, the impressive state capitol building, King Kamehameha's statue, and the National Cemetery of the Pacific. Then, remember Pearl Harbor with a visit to the World War II Valor in the Pacific National Monument, viewing artifacts from the attack and a short documentary on the "Day of Infamy." Travel by naval launch to view the white marble-clad USS *Arizona* Memorial, honoring those who lost their lives in the Pearl Harbor attack. (B, D)

Day 3: Saturday, May 8, 2027 Honolulu - Waikiki Dive further into Hawaiian history with a visit to Iolani Palace to learn about the Hawaiian monarchs and the takeover of Hawaii by the United States. Then enjoy free time for lunch with recommendations from your Tour Manager for the best spots for a traditional plated lunch. Later stop at the Pali lookout in O'ahu's rainforest before returning to Waikiki for an evening at your leisure. (B)

Day 4: Sunday, May 9, 2027 Honolulu - Hilo, Big Island - Hawai'i Volcanoes National Park - Kona Board your flight to the volcanic "Big Island" of Hawaii and leave cosmopolitan O'ahu behind. True to its name, the island itself is larger than all the other Hawaiian Islands combined. Although the island's official name is the archipelago's namesake, the Big Island is also famous for its volcanoes creating black, rocky landscapes. Upon arrival, pause at the iridescent mist of Rainbow Falls before having time to explore Hilo on your own for lunch. Then set out for a tour of the South Coast including a visit to Hawaii Volcanoes National Park to learn about Kilauea – the world's most active volcano. Make your way along the steam bluffs to get a view of the impressive caldera. On the way to the hotel take in views of the crystal-clear waters of Kealakekua Bay and visit one of the iconic black sand beaches where you may luck out in spotting a green turtle soaking up the sun. (B)

Day 5: Monday, May 10, 2027 Kona- Honaunau Bay - Kona Start the day at Pu'uhonua o Honaunau National Historical Park* on the rugged coast, once the place of refuge for those that broke the *Kapu* (sacred law) in old Hawaii. Then, visit St. Benedict's Painted Church, built in the 1800s and adorned with vibrant frescos. Continue to a coffee farm, which has been harvesting coffee beans since 1984. Tour the farm with a local before enjoying a tasting of the local brew. Return to the hotel for a private lei-making class taught by a local expert. Learn about its cultural significance and create one of your own to bring home. This evening, enjoy dinner Hawaiian-style, at a traditional Polynesian luau** featuring endless tropical drinks and a sumptuous feast. (B, D)

Day 6: Tuesday, May 11, 2027 Kona This morning, **it's your choice!** Enjoy an exclusive guided tour of the Kona Sea Salt Farm to learn about traditional Hawaiian salt harvesting **-OR-** a private guided visit to the Vanillerie to explore the history of vanilla beans and enjoy a sweet treat **-OR-** unwind at the hotel and relax at your own pace looking out over Big Island's rocky coastline. On the way back to the hotel, stop for lunch on your own in Kailua Kona*** – a town established by King Kamehameha I before he unified the Kingdom of Hawaii. (B, D)

Day 7: Wednesday, May 12, 2027 Kona - Kahului, Maui - Ka'anapali Board an inter-island flight to the "Valley Isle" of Maui, one of the most beautiful and popular outer islands. Visit the stunning Iao Valley and view the 2,000-foot-high Iao Needle, one of Maui's famous natural landforms. Travel to the resort area of Ka'anapali and arrive at your deluxe beachfront hotel. (B)

Day 8: Thursday, May 13, 2027 Maui Spend a day at leisure to see for yourself why locals say *Maui no ka oi* (Maui is the best). Perhaps you will take an optional full day cliff-side drive on the legendary Road to Hana. Or you may choose to take a stroll along the beach, shop for souvenirs or simply relax at your luxurious Maui resort. There is no limit to the adventures you can have on this gorgeous island! (B)

Day 9: Friday, May 14, 2027 Maui Enjoy another day in paradise. Take a swim in one of the many beaches along the coast or visit a nearby restaurant. (B, D)

Day 10: Saturday, May 15, 2027 Kahului - Lihue, Kauai A short flight takes you to the "Garden Isle" of Kauai, where you'll uncover the world of ancient Polynesia on the oldest island in

the chain. Upon arrival, travel to the breathtaking Waimea Canyon, carved thousands of years ago by rivers and floods. At 10 miles long, 1 mile wide, and more than 3,500 feet deep, it is considered the "Grand Canyon of the Pacific." (B)

Day 11: Sunday, May 16, 2027 Kauai The day is yours to enjoy this beautiful island at leisure. Stroll along the beach or take advantage of your resort's activities. (B)

Day 12: Monday, May 17, 2027 Wailua River - Lihue Step aboard an open-air boat for a cruise along the tranquil Wailua River. Your captain will tell stories of days gone by before making a stop at the lush Fern Grotto. Embark on a short guided walk before your return boat ride. Feel the Hawaiian spirit as hula dancers join you to demonstrate this ancient art form, originally performed for the volcano goddess Pele. Tonight, complete your wonderful trip with a farewell dinner at the first plantation house on the island. (B, D)

Day 13: Tuesday, May 18, 2027 Lihue - Tour Ends Bid Aloha to Hawaii as your memorable tour ends in Kauai.**** Now, wherever your home is, you'll always be part of the Hawaiian *ohana* (family). (B)

Important Tour Information:

Book Now rates valid until Nov 06, 2026, valid on air inclusive packages only.

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 1. This means you're a leisurely traveler. You typically take it easy and discover the energy of a new place by people-watching or soaking in the atmosphere at a local café. You can climb at least one flight of stairs, board a coach, and walk unassisted at a relaxed pace for up to 60 minutes without difficulty. You can easily handle altitudes up to 5,000 feet.

Travel with an average of 37 people (maximum of 44).

The most demanding inclusions are Bayview Coffee Plantation where you can expect to walk or stand for up to 45 minutes and Place of Refuge where you can expect sandy, uneven ground.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

Wind conditions at Pearl Harbor may result in a boat tour that does not include stopping at the USS *Arizona* Memorial. This is decided in the moment by the US Navy.

*The Place of Refuge is subject to weather conditions. In rare circumstances where the surf is high, the authorities may close the beach for safety concerns. If beach access is restricted during your tour, we will attempt to move the visit to another day or time, but cannot be guaranteed if the park remains closed.

***Those choosing to stay at the hotel will not have an included transfer to Kailua Kona and will be on their own at the resort.

Personal audio devices (headsets) are not included on this tour.

**Depending on the starting day of your tour, your luau may be swapped with another day on tour. All groups will still have a luau included.

Checkout time at your Kauai hotel is 11:00 a.m.

Resorts used on this tour are all relatively large and may require walking long distances to reach rooms or common areas.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

To complete your tour, we include round-trip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of purchasing these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.

Please be advised, many airlines do not provide advance seat assignments until check-in at the airport. Advance seating will be subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

****All return flights must be booked from Lihue Airport in Kauai.

Internal flights are required in order to participate on this tour and are included in the final price, quoted at time of booking.

Prepaid tipping is not available on our tours therefore payment of customary end-of-trip gratuities for your Tour Manager, driver, local guides, hotel housekeepers, and cruise ship waitstaff should be handled individually when applicable during the course of your tour.

Travel within USA

A Real ID compliant form of identification must be presented both at the time of booking air travel with Collette and upon checking in at the airport to board any flight.
