

HOW TO JOIN AND REGISTER FOR TRIPS

Arcadia Travelers Club, Inc is available for anyone 50+ You do not have to be a resident of Arcadia to participate in our club.

Come join us and participate in our trips. There are two (2) ways that you may register for a trip and/or pay our membership. You may pay in person at the Travel Office or by mail.

The Travel office is in the Arcadia Community Center at 365 Campus Drive, Arcadia, CA 91007. The Travel Office is open Monday through Friday from 9:00 am until 12:30 pm.

If you are mailing in the application for membership, simply download and fill out the application, ([Click](#)) enclose a \$10 check payable to Arcadia Travelers Club, Inc. and mail to Arcadia Travelers, 365 Campus Drive, Arcadia, CA, 91007. You **must be a member to register for a trip**. If you are registering for a trip at the same time, you are requesting a membership, we ask that you write two separate checks since the membership check is deposited into a different account than the trip registration.

If you are mailing in the registration for a day trip, click on ([TripFlyers](#)) to see a summary of upcoming day trips. Under the name of the trip, it indicates either a "Goes on sale date" or "On sale now." You can click on the trip in which you are interested to get more information from the flyer. **If you decide that a particular day trip is something of high interest to you, we highly recommend that you register for it at the office on the first day of registration.**

Be sure to fill out and print the registration form completely including the name of the trip, meal selection (if offered) and your emergency information. Enclose a check for the total cost of the trip made payable to Arcadia Travelers Club, Inc. Send to Arcadia Travelers, 365 Campus Drive, Arcadia, CA, 91006. If the trip is filled when your information arrives in our office, the office volunteer will call and ask you if you want to be put on the waitlist. Your check will be returned to you.

TRIP DIFFICULTY LEVEL

Perceptions of trip difficulty will vary widely so it is often difficult to characterize this in a single word or phrase. If there is specific information you should be aware of, it is on the trip flyer. The Office volunteers will be glad to help answer your questions and attending our monthly meetings at the Arcadia Community Center will help as the various trips are discussed in detail. The office number is (626) 821-4377. In most cases the general information on the flyer will be sufficient.

- 1 — Easy, a little walking, good for all
- 2 — Moderate, normal walking, but must be able to walk long distances, on and off the bus several times
- 3 — Active, lots of walking, may include multiple staircases, Lots of getting on and off the bus
