

Anacapa Island Whale Watching and Wildlife Cruise

Join Curt Tucker on this fun and educational day provides the perfect way to discover Channel Island National Park, a treasure in the sea. Our exploration begins at the Chanel Island National Park visitors center, featuring a display of marine aquatic life. Then enjoy time at leisure in the picturesque Ventura Harbor Village to take a stroll along the waterfront promenade, browse the boutiques and art galleries and enjoy lunch on your own at a variety of casual eateries. This afternoon we'll embark on a 3 hour narrated whale watching cruise through the waters of Santa Barbara Channel. In addition to whales, you might see other marine mammals like dolphins, seals, and sea lions. On this non landing cruise, we'll journey along the rugged shoreline and surrounding waters of Anacapa Island with views of the famous Arch Rock, the working lighthouse atop the island and a variety of wildlife. Our larger passenger vessel features a restroom on board and offers both indoor and outdoor seating on multiple decks. A snack bar is available to purchase drinks and snacks.
