#### ARCHIVAL TIDBITS FROM THE TRAVEL DESK

On September 24, 1982, Arcadia Travelers began when By-laws were approved and the first official general meeting was held. According to the minutes of 1982, the reason for forming the organization was "To get people out of their homes."

The original Arcadia Travelers office was located at the Arcadia City Hall.

Arcadia Travelers general meetings were held in the City Council Chambers and dues were \$3.00

Betty Harris represented the City and attended all meetings, both Board and General.

All trips were planned and organized by individual escorts with approval of the Travel Coordinator.

The first four trips were: Pepperdine College: \$10.00, Christmas Lights: \$12.50, Holiday on Ice: \$13.50, and 2-nights in Las Vegas (double) \$65.00.

Every meeting one \$5.00 gift certificate was raffled.

In 1989 Arcadia Travelers had 1,200 members.

In 1990 Arcadia Travelers moved to the Community Center.

### DAY TRIP NEWS:

Trip Coordinator, Chris Ohrmund, reports that the remaining 2020 day trips have now been rescheduled for dates in 2021. Both trips, Hamilton at the Pantages, now scheduled on May 23, 2021, and the Neil Diamond Tribute performance, now scheduled on July 20, 2021. We're keeping our fingers crossed that the venues will reopen in time for these highly anticipated performances.
