First we'll drive through Chinatown, a festive and colorful destination for dining and shopping. Pagoda-style buildings with red lanterns house traditional Chinese restaurants, dim sum houses and bakeries. We will visit the Chinese American Museum, that is symbolically housed in the oldest and last surviving structure of L.A.'s original Chinatown, and is the first such museum in Southern California dedicated to the Chinese American experience and history in this region. Celebrate the Chinese New Year, THE YEAR OF THE TIGER with an included authentic Chinese lunch. Beyond the colorful Fire Tower and Buddhist Temples of Little Tokyo is a major historic, cultural and vibrant asian enclave, with its roots dating back to the 1880's. Every day Little Tokyo bustles with activity and authenticity. Enjoy the "World's Best Cream Puff" from Beard Papas, a popular bakery chain that originated in Japan. Our journey ends in Koreatown, a sprawling community that has become one of the city's hippest areas, thanks to the continuing renovation of its rich architectural heritage. A stop at the Korean Cultural Center, where you'll experience the rich traditions and history of Korea, that boasts contemporary artifacts as well as a variety of replicas of historical pieces from Korea's dynastic kingdoms.
